Congratulations and thank you! Your abstract for the paper titled Interpreting Canonical Correspondence Analysis in SAS has been accepted for the Statistics, Modeling & Analysis section of NESUG 2012, to be held in Baltimore, MD, from November 11 - 14. The scheduled length of your presentation is 20 minutes, including questions.

This acceptance is conditional upon timely receipt and final review and acceptance of your completed paper and presentation materials. The deadlines for those are shown below. We would like to thank you in advance for your efforts and are looking forward to working with you.

The designated Primary Presenter must register for, and attend, NESUG 2012 in order for your paper to be included in the conference Proceedings. Please confirm that you intend to attend. If you will not be able to attend the conference please let us know who will be the Primary Presenter for your paper.

NESUG 2012 Important Dates:

1. A draft paper must be submitted via the NESUG CFP website by August 10.
2. A final paper must be submitted via the NESUG CFP website by September 10.

This is what will get published. This final file must be a PDF, named with your paper number, which will be assigned shortly. Please label any files you upload to the NESUG CFP website using your assigned paper code, such as ccnn.pdf, ccnn.zip, or ccnn.ppt - where cc is the section code and nn represents your paper number.

3. You must submit a scanned and signed Permission to Publish form via the NESUG CFP website. The form must be signed by all authors of the paper, by August 10.
4. A draft presentation file should be uploaded to the CFP website by October 11.

5. The presenter must register for the NESUG conference between June 28 and September 14.

Online registration will open June 28 and you will receive a Primary Presenter discount code to use when you register. Please note that you must register by the early registration deadline of September 14 to take advantage of the Primary Presenter discount. Only one Primary Presenter discount per paper is allowed.

6. A final presentation file must be submitted via the NESUG CFP website by November 9.

7. You will need to make your own travel arrangements. Hotel information is available on the website. The last date for the guaranteed room rate discount is October 12, subject to availability.

8. The conference dates are November 11 - 14, 2012. Your presentation may be scheduled for any time during the Monday, Tuesday, or on Wednesday morning. If you have more than one abstract accepted, we will ensure your presentations aren't scheduled at the same time. Beyond that, we can't guarantee the schedule until very close to the conference date. Please plan your travel to allow you to attend a meeting of presenters at 4:00 pm on Sunday, November 11 at the conference hotel. We will review final details and ensure that your presentation is loaded onto the section laptop.

The deadlines above fall in what tends to be a popular vacation season. If you are going to be unavailable around the deadline dates, please upload your file(s) at least a few days before you plan to be away and let us (your section chairs) know that you have done so.
